The average temperature in Mauritius during November is 29°C, with evenings staying nice and warm at 20°C. The sea temperature is 25°C, which is lovely for swimming, while humidity's moderate. There's 66mm of rain over 12 days, and you can look forward to 13 hours of daylight with eight hours of sunshine each day.

No dangerous snakes, spiders or animals live in these areas.

Time keeping system

SPORT IDENT punching system will be used during all competitions. You need to PUNCH all controls including START and FINISH. NO air system!!

SI cards can be hired from the organizers at the race office.

Map exchange: There will be MAP EXCHANGE for both courses! Maps are printed on both sides of the map, and you only flip the map. The second part will start at the same control point as the first part ends (NO start triangle).

Terrain: forest with different vegetation from open to dense, moderate density of paths, deep

and steep valleys, mostly good runnability and visibility


