It is also possible to pick up number bibs directly at first competition.

Thursday **17th November**

Super sprint

Location: Palmar Beach

First start: 11.00

Terrain: Open beach forest, very good runnability and visibility, soft surface – only 100m asphalt, altitude 0m

Recommended: shorts, all kinds of O-shoes

Course planner: Jaroslav Kacmarcik

Course lengths: only 2 courses: Men and Women (Fastest times 10-11min)

Event centre – START: 200m marked

Start interval: one minute (M/W 21-50) and two minutes for other classes

Control descriptions: Printed on the map and also separate ones

Map exchange: There will be MAP EXCHANGE for both courses! Maps are printed on both sides of the map, and you only flip the map. The second part will start at the same control point as the first part ends – NEW START marked by TRIANGLE

Special prizes: for runners who “beat” the times of Megan Carter-Davies – 2022 Sprint World Champion – on women’s course and Yannick Michiels – 2022 Sprint World Championship Bronze medallist – on men’s course

Extra: Public toilets and public showers available on spot. The beach is usually windy. Remember sunscreen!

Water: There will be ‘some’ water (served or sold) on every stage, but please take also your own water with you as the weather will be hot. Take enough

Food: There will be a food truck selling drinks and food

Prize giving ceremony: After the race for class winners

Friday 18th November

Middle distance

Signposts from Road B86 in Banane GPS: 20°20'58.24"S / 57°35'41.49"O

will start signing with O-Flags to competition area (but also use google maps to be sure)

First start: 10:00

Terrain: Forest with different vegetation from open to dense, moderate density of paths, deep and steep valleys, mostly good runnability and visibility, darkest greens very dense

Recommended: long socks, all kinds of O-shoes (studs if rain)

Course lengths: Approximately 4km (longest course)

START: in event centre

Start interval: 2 minutes

Control descriptions: Printed on the map and also separate ones

ATTENTION: Map was made in November 2021 and printed in printing house before arriving to Mauritius. **There are 2 changes, where the map is out-of-date:** One fence has been removed

and one fence has been added in the terrain. These changes are not marked in the competition map, but will be shown on a clean map in INFO desk

Extra: Toilets and showers are available on spot. Remember sunscreen!

Water: There will be 'some' water (served or sold) on every stage, but please take also your own water with you as the weather will be hot.
