2. Site Description:

With its rich and varied terrain, the Coloane offers a natural diversity of challenges for orienteering. The mountainous terrain and dense woods in the south-west of the island test participants' physical fitness and orienteering skills, while the open flatlands in the north-east of the island are suitable for competitors of all levels. The island's highly distinctive humanistic landscapes, such as the St Francis of Assisi Church and the fishing village at Coloane, are both distinctive carding points and rich in the cultural connotation of the sport. Perfect infrastructure, including good roads, reasonably distributed rest and supply points, stable communication and sanitary facilities, provide strong protection for the event. The subtropical oceanic monsoon climate makes it a pleasant climate for prolonged outdoor sports except for the summer heat, attracting orienteering enthusiasts throughout the year.

IV. Entry method

(1) There is no limit to the number of participants from each unit, and the representative team can report one leader and one coach each.

(2) Athletes must have the ability to participate in competitive orienteering activities.

5. Admission rankings and awards

(1) ME/WE, M/W21A: Each division awards the top eight men and women with certificates, medals, and trophies for the top three. The remaining divisions will award the top three male and female finishers with certificates.

(2) Athletes in all categories who have successfully completed the individual events within the valid time according to the competition rules will be awarded a finisher's certificate and a finisher's medal.

(3) For all categories with less than 3 entries, there will be no prizes for placing, but only finishers' certificates.

(4) Bonus incentives:

1. The first 6 places in World Ranking Event Men & Women's classes will be rewarded in each event regardless of nationalities.

Located at the Jesuit Memorial Square, it can be reached by bus from Avenida de Almeida Ribeiro Station, just a few minutes' walk away.



Macau Tower

Macau's new landmark, 338 meters high, is one of the world's top ten observation towers. You can enjoy the panoramic view of Macau, as well as bungee jumping and other exciting programs, not dare to bungee jumping can also stroll

in the observation deck. The address is in front of the Macau Tower, easily accessible by bus or taxi.



2. Food Recommendations:

Macau, with its rich and varied cuisine. Specialties top the list of Portuguese cuisine, and the Portuguese Chicken and Ma Jai-Ho Balls at Dumbo Portuguese Restaurant are classics and worth a try. Cantonese seafood hot pot is also excellent, with abundant seafood platters, suitable for family dinners. Among the specialty snacks, the Portuguese egg tart with crispy skin and tender inner filling at Princess Margaret Egg Tart Shop is a must-try in Macau; the shrimp lo mein at Wong Chi Kee is strong in noodles and full of shrimp flavor; and the beef mince at Old Day Beef and Minced Beef

Shop is flavorful with a special sauce that makes it a delightful meal.

In the realm of luxury dining, the new Cantonese cuisine at Yulon Heen is exquisite, the French restaurant at the Heaven's Nest offers a view of Macau while enjoying a meal, and the French cuisine at Ducasse has its own distinctive charm.
